Public search

Public search controls whether people who enter your name in a search engine will see a preview of your Facebook profile. Because some search engines cache information, some of your profile information may be available for a period of time after you turn public search off. [See preview](#)

To use this feature, first go to [Basic Directory Information](#) and set "Search for me on Facebook" to "Everyone."

- ⑩ Change your Privacy Settings to limit the information you share.
- ⑩ Protect your password at all times.
- ⑩ Make sure nothing in the picture gives away personal info. For Example, Location
- ⑩ Challenge the safety of sites, do not give your personal information away to unsecured sites (Not even for a free iPad)
- ⑩ Check your friends pages, make sure they do not have any personal information about you. (Look at the number of friends)
- ⑩ Instant messaging and E-mail are not considered forms of secure online communication.
- ⑩ Limit the number of friends you have online. They are the link to your “Privacy”.
- ⑩ Do not use the same screen name for multiple sites.
- ⑩ Update your computer regularly, Microsoft issues updates on selected Tuesdays
